PENALTIES, FOULS & CROSSING



1.

The white player has the line, and at fair speed the black player would be crossing the line without sufficient safety margin, resulting in a penalty against black.



Even at a far lesser angle the black player would still be crossing the line if he continues in that direction, and committing a dangerous foul.

When travelling in the same direction the black player may draw level with white and then force him across the line and take possession of the ball


without committing a

foul or incurring a

penalty.

Two players riding for a ball from opposite directions in the open must both give way to the left and take the ball on their right or offside.

When two players are approaching a ball in the open from different directions, the player (Black), with the line of the ball on his offside, right hand side, has the right of way.


