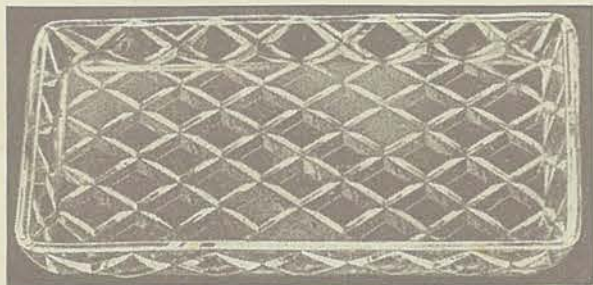

AUSTRALASIAN POLO CUP

Donated by Hon. R. T. Melrose, M.L.C., and Mr. Anthony Hordern, C.B.E., in 1925, for Representative Interstate Teams

This Cup was presented in 1925 by the Hon. R. T. Melrose, M.L.C., and Mr. Anthony Hordern, C.B.E., for competition between the Polo Associations of New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia, West Australia, Tasmania, Queensland, and New Zealand.

CONDITIONS

1. That the Cup be a perpetual Challenge Trophy, to be called the Australasian Polo Cup.
2. The Competition to be confined to teams from the Polo Associations of Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, West Australia, New South Wales, Tasmania, and New Zealand. Such teams must be recognised and approved of by their respective Associations, and must be limited to three teams from each Association. The players must be members of Clubs affiliated with the respective Associations, and no player from one State can play with a team representing another State.
3. The Tournament shall be held at the Kensington Racecourse Ground on Saturday, 24th June.
4. No limitation shall be made with regard to the number of ponies played by any team, but no pony that has played with one team during the Tournament shall be allowed to play with another. In the event of a pony being incapacitated by any sickness or injury, such pony may be replaced by another pony, with the approval of the Committee.
5. The games shall be played under the Hurlingham Rules, as amended by the New South Wales, Victorian and South Australian Polo Associations in 1924.
6. The matches in 1933 will be six chukkas.

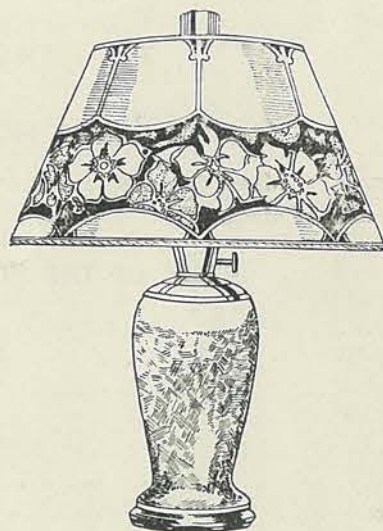

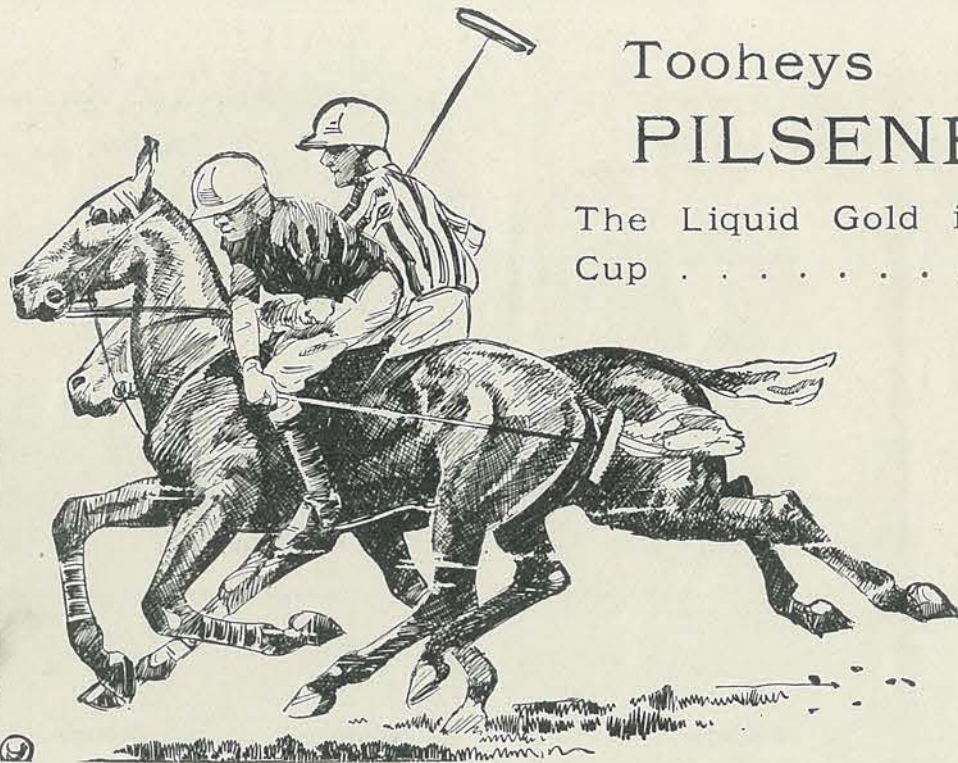
